# Evangelism Class #15 Outline - Preparing for Objections

#### 1 Peter 3:14-15

- **What:** Give reasons for our hope. **How:** With gentleness and reverence. **Why:** Because Jesus is sanctified in our hearts.

#### 1. Be Honest if you Don't Know

- Don't make stuff up to defend God. Don't defend truth with lies.

### 2. Be Humble if you Don't Know

 Don't make stuff up to "save face" and defend yourself. Don't get angry/defensive if you don't have the answers.

## 3. There are Some Things we Can't Know

- **Deuteronomy 29:29** Don't apologize for what God didn't tell us, don't speak for God either.
  - **Key:** Can almost always point people in a helpful direction based on what we DO know.

### 4. Be Willing to Do Research

- 2 Timothy 2:15 Don't need to be experts, but will need to do research if we're going to help people through objections.
  - Research the Bible, apologetics books/articles, and material objectors give us.

### 5. Be Sympathetic

- 2 Timothy 2:24-26 Intellectual sympathy, emotional sympathy, and volitional sympathy.
  - Try to understand why they have objections and be gentle.

## 6. Praise Good Objections

- At least they're thinking enough to form objections!
- Benefit: Shows them God isn't afraid of their questions.
  - John 20:25-29 Jesus invites examination, He doesn't run from it!

#### 7. Be Brief

- Most people don't know much and only need to know that there are answers.
- Don't need a huge presentation.

#### 8. Use Illustrations

 Most objections stem from misunderstanding. Paint a picture and relate it to what they already understand.

### 9. Aim for Clarity, not Agreement

- They don't have to agree, just make sure they understand our answer.

#### 10. Point People to Jesus, the Ultimate Answer

- Jesus is the answer to every objection.
- 1 Peter 3:15 HE is the reason for our hope.
