Don't underestimate the power of sharing your conversation story. Dry facts without subjective experience is empty.

Acts 26:9-20

1. Share what you used to think and do about Jesus

 Acts 26:9-11 - Sharing our pre-Christian misconceptions and wrong living helps us relate to people.

2. Share what happened to change your heart and mind

 Acts 26:12-15 - What changed your misconceptions? What happened to bring you face to face with reality?

3. Share your new view of Jesus

- Acts 26:15 After the previous thing happened, how did you now view God, Jesus, and/or religion?
 - You knew He was Savior. You knew He loved you. You knew you needed His grace, etc.

4. Share your new purpose and how your life changed

- Acts 26:16-20 - Did you overcome a sin? Did you have new motivation for living? Did you have your path in life made clearer? etc.

How do we handle quick encounters with strangers?

- **Important:** Talking to strangers is difficult and not very effective. Even if you manage to say the perfect thing in such a short time, they still don't know or trust you.
- Take principles from class and condense them.
 - 1) Be friendly and show interest
 - 2) Give a sincere compliment
 - 3) Use spiritual small talk that makes them think
 - 4) If you hand them a card, acknowledge the awkwardness and ask permission
 - 5) Handle rejection with kindness and respect
 - They might not be rejecting God, just you and the situation.
 - People are hardwired to say "no," when they get any hint of someone selling something.
 - Remember, successful evangelism is about bringing people one step closer to obeying the gospel. Might not convert a stranger, but we can point them in the right direction and move Jesus one step away from Stranger and toward Friend/Savior.
