March 6th, 2022 - 5 Keys to Handling the Deacon Objection Period Well

We're so blessed to have qualified men to potentially serve as deacons. This Wednesday, March 9th, is the final day to submit their names to the shepherds, and the shepherds plan to announce those names next Sunday, March 13th. From that point, you'll have 10 days to voice any objections you have to the men whose names were submitted. Hopefully we won't even need this article because there won't be any objections, but if there are, it can be awkward and difficult, so here are some keys to handling it well.



Key #1: Pray. Pray for courage to speak to the potential deacon. Pray that he'll have a receptive heart. Pray for clarity in your speech (Colossians 4:4). Potential deacons, pray for a heart to listen well. "The way of a fool is right in his own eyes, but a wise man is he who listens to counsel." (Proverbs 12:15). Let's all pray God is glorified in this process.

Key #2: Make sure it's a Scriptural objection. He may have a different parenting style than yours, but that doesn't make him a bad parent Scripturally. He may have hurt your feelings, but it doesn't mean he sinned against you according to God's Word. His sense of humor may be dryer than yours, but it doesn't make him irreverent. It's important to only voice an objection if he has, or is, clearly violating Scripture in some way.

Key #3: How you respond is part of the "test." Paul says, "These men must first be tested; then let them serve as deacons if they are beyond reproach." (1 Tim. 3:10). Potential deacons, if someone approaches you with an objection and you fly off the handle, you're only proving you're not qualified to serve.

<u>Key #4</u>: Be gracious to the potential deacon. This won't be easy for him. It'll be awkward and unpleasant to hear from someone who disagrees he's qualified. Use a gentle, kind, loving tone. Make it clear you're on his side and only want the best for him because he's your brother in Christ. "The tongue of the wise makes knowledge <u>acceptable</u>, but the mouth of fools spouts folly." (Proverbs 15:2)

Key #5: Be gracious to the objector. Potential deacons, realize it takes tremendous courage for this person to approach you. If their words don't come out right because they're nervous, or maybe they're charging you with something that's not sin, be patient and gracious. "With humility, gentleness, and patience, show tolerance for one another in love." (Eph. 4:2). Put yourselves in their shoes and really try to see it from their perspective. Even if you didn't do anything sinful, you may have hurt this person inadvertently. A gracious response will seek reconciliation and to heal any hurt that hinders your relationship with this brother or sister in Christ (Matthew 5:23-24).

May God be with us all in the uncomfortable moments now so that there won't be any doubt or discomfort with the men we appoint as deacons; only rejoicing!
